
1.2M electric in 149 comm.232,000 natural gas in 71 comm.198,000 water in 51 comm.

1.4M electric in 140 comm292,000 natural gas in 51 comm.19,500 water in five comm.


New Hampshire:

510,000 electric in 211 comm.9,500 water in three com.




Our Future is a Hybrid Grid


