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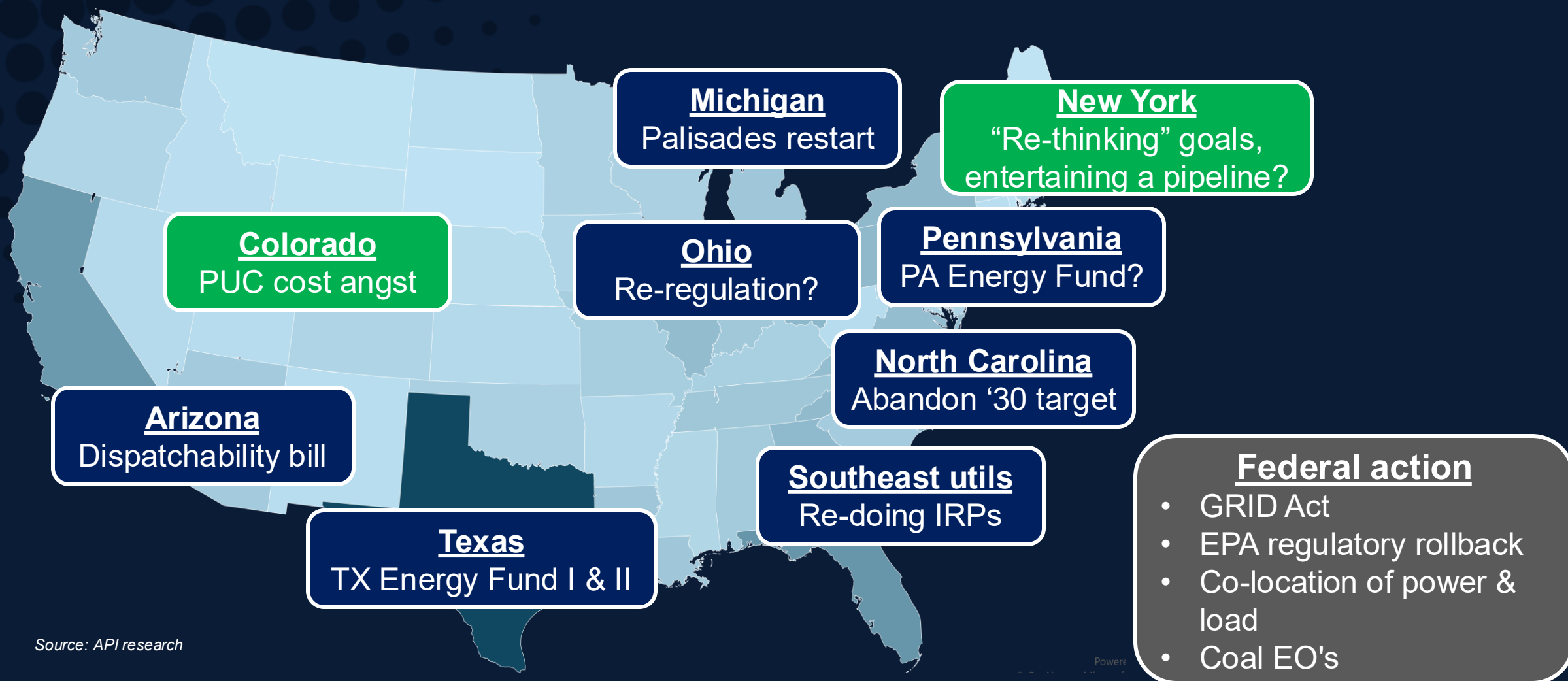

Priorities for Energy Infrastructure Permitting Reform

- To fully harness the power of American energy, support consumers, promote energy security and protect the environment – permitting reform legislation should be based on key elements of:
 - Transparency and predictability,
 - Timeliness and efficiency, and
 - Judicial durability.
- In particular, specific legislative changes are needed to:
 - The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA),
 - Sections 401 and 404 of the Clean Water Act (CWA), and
 - Judicial review of agency decisions.
