


## Transmission to Scale Offshore Wind in Massachusetts and New England



Massachusetts	3.2 GW
Rhode Island	0.4 GW
Connecticut	2.3 GW
New York	9 GW
New Jersey	3.5 GW
Total	17.4 GW

The Northeast's offshore wind potential of up to 50 GW significantly exceeds current state commitments of 17 GW.





## **Time to Plan Transmission**

- Planned transmission will determine how much of the 15-20GW of offshore wind potential off the south coast of Massachusetts can be reached.
- 2. Planned transmission is better for fishing interests, the ocean environment, coastal communities, competition, resiliency, jobs, and building an industry.
- 3. New England states must develop a transmission strategy to address <u>cumulative</u> impacts of offshore wind, and issue transmission RFPs ASAP.
