

Requiring regulated entities to pursue grants, tax incentives, and low-cost financing


Exploring tiered discount rates, disconnection protection changes, eligibility, and verification




MASSACHUSETTS ENERGY BURDEN

23% of households reported having to go without expenses like food or healthcare to pay their energy bill in the last year.

Electric Sector Modernization Plans ("ESMPs") are strategic plans that facilitate interconnection of DERs and evaluate options and alternatives through equity framework

Net Metering now allows transfer of credits across utilities and load zones, exempts facilities from caps serving on-site load, further changes to come in late 2024

Approved one low-income community shared solar initiative and directed refiling of another


